TODAY

- ☐ Remove combustible debris from roofs, gutters, decks, and the area immediately around structures.: Follow current state and local defensible-space requirements.
- ☐ Inspect vents, screens, windows, doors, roofs, and gaps where embers may enter.: Use qualified professionals for building modifications.
- ☐ Test HVAC, obtain compatible filters, size portable cleaners, and identify a clean-air room.: Keep replacement filters ready before demand rises.
- ☐ Register for alerts, photograph property, stage go bags, and practice two evacuation routes.: Home preparation never justifies delaying evacuation.

REMEMBER

- ☐ Prepare the property for embers and the interior for smoke: maintain defensible space, harden vulnerable openings, test alerts, and set up filtration before the first red-flag warning.
- ☐ Follow official evacuation orders, local public-health guidance, and individual medical or veterinary advice.
